It also responds to market need for experts in environmental law within government, business, civil society and international agencies. Faculty members bring scholarly, practical and public service skills and experience in various disciplines of environmental law including land law, land use law, natural resource management, climate change law, biodiversity conservation, environmental impacts assessment, access to justice, alternative dispute resolution, international aspects, transboundary resource management, legal and institutional reforms, among other areas.

The specific objectives of the Environmental Policy Programme are to:

1. Enable students to have good knowledge of environmental law and equip them with hands-on and relevant skills in environmental governance;
2. Provide specialised training for those interested in practising environmental law as a specialised discipline either as drafters, legal advisers, corporate lawyers or legal practitioners;
3. Develop a cadre of professionals with skills and expertise to incorporate environmental considerations in all planning and legal instruments
4. Promote knowledge and insights for protection of the threshold of sustainability in the utilization or enjoyment of the environment
5. Prepare managers for informed interventions, avoidance and/or settlement of disputes on environmental matters; and
6. Offer quality training to prepare those aspiring to pursue scholarship at doctoral, research or teaching levels to ensure inter-generational succession of environmental management expertise
